A Scholarship Fund has variable paths for meeting your wishes. You may designate merit, need, and academic pursuits when designing your scholarship program, or you may use a formula already established. You may identify the schools the student has attended or will be attending, including secular, private, or religious; primary schools, secondary schools, colleges or universities, or technical schools.

A Scholarship Fund may be established by an individual, family, group, business or charitable organization with an opening balance of \$15,000.

Consider this:

1. Our scholarships can support students of all ages who are obtaining their education and degrees at every level in the educational system.
2. Scholarships may benefit a particular group of people such as women, people of color, or residents of a particular community.
3. Scholarship awards can be one-time or recurring over a period of time.
4. The Burlington Community Fund will ensure that scholarship recipients meet fund criteria and fulfill scholarship award requirements.
